Uses

Impregnation of stators and armatures.

Cured Properties

The Pedigree 433-75-VTC is a high bond resin. It has excellent high temperature resistance and is included in UL recognized insulation systems up to Class 220.

Catalyst

No catalyst is required.

Recommended Cure

After unit has reached temperature, cure at 150° to 200° C (300° to 390°F) for 2 to 3 hours.

Application Methods

- Dip and Bake
- Vacuum Pressure Impregnation (VPI)
- Vacuum Impregnation (VI)

Storage/Shelf Life

This resin should be stored at a 25 °C (77 °F) in a dry controlled environment out of direct sunlight. This material should be suitable for use stored under these conditions in the original sealed containers for six (6) months from the date of shipment.
